For this current art show: *Anticipation and Celebration* –for Advent and Christmas 2023 at Marble, she created the online gallery presentation featuring photos from Marble artists; including her photo and one original fine art print..

On the Wall are 2 original art pieces created in her style: ArtInscribe for

Advent. *Hope, Joy, Peace, Love* represents the themes of Advent and *O Come Immanuel* which present the words of our prayers for the coming of Jesus at Christmas. ArtInscribe integrates and inscribes free flowing geometric shapes with the forms of the letters of the words, creating an integrated harmonious art piece. It is then printed with archival ink and paper for a fine art print. *Madonna and Child* is originally hand drawn and then formatted for the computer to print this fine art archival print.

Madonna and Child is also featured in the video. *Santa at Macy's --Santa for All*, is my photo featured in the online video show. I was at the Macy's parade Thanksgiving 2023 and just caught this photo..It felt like Santa was looking right in my direction (maybe waving at me?) This photo is of Santa connecting to all in the spirit of our holiday.
