Her ears were attuned to a variety of wonderful music since infancy by her father's diverse record collection. She received her first camera at age 7, a gift from her photographer father. She began composing on piano at 17, then self-taught on guitar from age 20, began her lifelong journey into songwriting, and an exploration into musical theatre, music performance and recording with various musical friends and situations. Lisa loves to sing—jazz, folk, harmony, pop, and is constantly inspired to create songs, musical prayers, stories and poetry. She is a published poet, artist, photographer, working on various projects: memoir,

poetry, children's books, novel and musical theatre. Lisa does professional editing and book design, assisting people in their publishing endeavors. Creative Women's Network is lisa's d/b/a home based design and literary services venture. She is a former educator as well as eldercaregiver. She is very much an ecopoet and songstress, weaving topics of nature, spirituality and matters of the heart into her creative works. She endeavors to write screenplays in the near future and build a publishing cooperative. Lisa is preparing her poetry and photography book, entitled Emerging from Limbo / Haikuisized, for publication soon.

ElectrikGoddess is lisa roma's musical aka, as well as concept band originally founded in 2004. In the early 1980s, lisa began to perform her songs with guitar at poetry readings in New York City. She took a hiatus to raise her son in the mid-1980s and returned to performing at open mics and various venues in the 1990s, solo with guitar and with fellow musician friends. She created the virtual theatre The Half Moon Theatre Company in 2008 while working with Rob Darnell. With Rob, they performed his funk operas, as well as their collaborative poetic musical story "Rustic Shadow on a Summer Tree". She performed the music of Laura Nyro and other artists, collaborating with Rob Darnell Hollinsed, arranger, choral director, founder of Poetic Notion Chorus and Poetic Notion Experience, as well as creating and hosting The Half Moon Artist Series, where we would invite additional local artists to perform, from December 2006 thru January 2012. Lisa has performed over the years in various Brooklyn and Manhattan venues, most notably University of The Streets with Poetic Notion, as well as Puppets Jazz Bar, BBQ's, and other local jazz clubs, cafes and dives. She is currently making a resurgence in live performing, which began with PorchStomp in June 2023, and will be singing jazz
